## Join the Women's Network Leadership Team!

For 2018 the DISH Women's Network is "hiring" for our leadership team! Get involved and help build this grass-roots, employee-run network! The below positions are open and if you are interested, you can use the link below to submit your name and information. While most of these roles are Meridian based, if you are interested in starting a DISH Women's Network chapter at your office, please let us know by selecting "Chapter Manager".

- **Video Editing Manager** – In this role, you will help deliver final video recordings of our Leader Series for our non-Meridian employees to watch! The role will include editing the video recordings of the DISH Women's Network Leader Series and any other applicable recorded events. Prior experience with professional video editing software is strongly preferred. These videos are used on our website and are a key way to help share the insight and stories from the leaders who come speak for the Network.
- **Video/AV Lead** – This role will help record the monthly DISH Women's Network Leader Series. Recording these events allows our non-Meridian employees to engage with the Network and experience our events from their locations. This role requires a technical background in video recording and audio. Access to equipment a plus, but the DWN team does have a limited video set up. This role also includes interacting with our guest executives as they speak for the Network.
- **Brand Manager** – This position will provide support and coordination for the team managing DISH Women's Network content and brand including our newsletter, social media and blog. Acting as a coordinator of calendars and content, this position will help guide the team creating unique and original material for DWN. Experience with brand marketing preferred and a strong aptitude for time management, team leadership and coordination will help this position succeed!
- **Monthly Networking Lead** – This position will manage a soon-to-launch monthly networking event on campus at Meridian. The lead will coordinate the room booking, marketing for the event, coordinate any refreshments needed, and lead the event each month. As a new program offering, this role will be foundational in driving our networking strategy and helping connect employees across the business. This position will join the Employee Engagement team for the DISH Women's Network.
- **Lead, Web Development** – Our website is a key infrastructure requirement to make the Network successful. The platform for sharing our content with off-site employees as well as telling our story with visitors, the website is a crucial strategic tool for the Network. This role will join the Infrastructure Team which oversees the DWN website. Supporting in web site updates, back end updates, and website improvements, this role will work with the Digital Manager and web team. Experience with WordPress preferred.
- **Chapter Manager** – Bring the DISH Women's Network to your location or get involved by sharing our resources on your site! This role is flexible based on your location and we have a team to support you in rolling out the Network. The team will support you in your initiatives and will help drive engagement at your location.
- **Liaison Program Manager** – This position will manage the DISH Women's Network liaison program and team members. The manager will schedule and lead quarterly liaison meetings, provide regular updates to the liaisons, and recruit new liaisons as necessary. This position will join the Employee Engagement team for the DISH Women's Network.
